What are the differences? Middle School

Students have more accountability from teachers and parents.

Students are preparing to become responsible for their grades and studies.

High School

Classes that receive a non passing grade need to be made up (summer school or the following year).

Students are accountable for themselves and their school work.

- GPA:3.0* calculated on approved a-g courses completed in grades 10-11
- SAT Reasoning or ACT with writing combination.

STANDARDIZED TESTS

- ACTASPIRE test will be taken in 9th and 10th grade
 - PSAT will be taken in 10th and 11th grade
 - SAT and ACT tests should be taken by the Spring of 11th grade year.
 - Plan on taking the tests at least twice.
